- 2. We will send you a quote with an itinerary showing what is included.
- 3. Once you receive your quote from us, get in touch and we will make any provisional bookings required. If it is a tour with flights, these will need to be confirmed as soon as possible with a deposit per person.
- 4. We will send you an Invoice for the deposit for coach tours & will confirm a payment plan by e-mail for tours with flights. For Coach Day Trips, no deposit is required unless a pre-paid venue is requested.
- 5. For coach tours please send us a £750 deposit to secure your booking. This can be done by cheque or Bank Transfer.
- 6. For coach tours 8 Weeks prior to departure, you will need to pay the balance owed. For tours with flights, it is usually 14 to 16 weeks prior to departure.
- 7. Approximately 4 weeks prior to departure, we will send you your Tour Pack containing your finalised itinerary, your accommodation & venue details and background information about the places you will visit.

All Group Leaders will be supplied with a Tour Pack containing details of what you have booked, important contact numbers and names and the itinerary and Tour Notes on each destination and venue you visit with your group.

### KidZania is an indoor city, run by kids!

Your students can independently choose from a number of reallife entertaining activities in one safe and secure space.

Designed for children aged 4-14, KidZania blends learning and reality with entertainment.

Here your students will be able to get a fun and realistic insight into the adult world by taking part in a choice of 'jobs' which run by kids!

When you get in to KidZania, you will find yourself at our British Airways Airport check-in area.

### anne frank house

### A Museum with a Story......

Anne Frank is a Jewish girl who had to go into hiding during World War Two to escape from the Nazis. Together with seven others she hid in the Secret Annex at Prinsengracht 263 in Amsterdam.

After more than two years in hiding they were discovered and deported to concentration camps. Anne's father, Otto Frank, was the only one of the eight people to survive.

After her death Anne became World famous because of the diary she wrote while in hiding, telling the story of what it was like to live in constant fear.



The Anne Frank House is a museum with a story. As a visitor, you experience this story through quotes, photos, videos, and original items. The atmosphere in the museum is both authentic and subdued. All through the museum, you can still see traces and personal objects of the people who hid there.

Following a tour of the house, you will be able to visit the café and or the Gift Shop.

The museum has many educational materials that can be used by the students to explore the question of prejudice, freedom of choice and citizenship which can be accessed through their website prior to your visit.

### **Iceland & Northern Lights**

### **Itinerary Ideas & Suggested 4-Days**

### Day 1: Reykjanes Peninsula and Hveragerdi

Arrive at Keflavik on the South West Reykjanes Peninsula of Iceland.

- 'Bridge Between Continents' & the Stampar Craters & bubbling mud pools at Gunnuhver.
- The iconic lighthouse at Reykjanesviti before stopping for lunch.
- Geothermal area of Seltun
- The town of Hveragerdi, where the inhabitants use geothermal energy to their advantage

### Day 2: Waterfalls, Solheimajokull glacier and black beaches

- Seljalandsfoss view it from behind the waterfall itself.
- Gljiufrabui, a waterfall which cascades into a huge cavern
- Skogafoss, one of Iceland's most iconic sites
- the enormous glacier, Solheimajokull. This glacier has been retreating due to climate change
- the famous Icelandic coastline between Reynishverfi and Dyrholaey, the black sands which featured in Game of Thrones.

### Day 3: Golden Circle

Your last full day in Iceland will focus on the classic Golden Circle tour.

- Iceland's most reliable geyser Strokkur which erupts every 6 minutes or so.
- Gullfoss, a stepped waterfall
- the rift valley at Thingvellir national park
- Reykjavik

### Day 4: Statue of Liberty


- Take the ferry and visit Ellis Island and Statue of Liberty.
